Sex and Love Addicts Anonymous Fellowship Wide Services Inc (FWS) conducts a member survey every four to six years. In 2018, 841 members kindly participated by responding to the detailed questions set out in the attached Table. Our expectation is well over 1000 will respond to the 2024 Survey. The CPIC will ensure the collected data be distributed to an audience of professionals. It was intended that findings from the survey be provided free of charge to be used as an aid to:

- Health care professionals Media and news professionals
- Correctional facilities professionals Researchers and students; and Treatment facilities professionals
- Members of the public seeking information about SLAA. Employee assistance professionals.
