<b>Charter or Purpose of the Committee</b>
The Conference Literature Committee (CLC) fosters quality literature in support of SLAA recovery; guides the planning, writing, and editing of literature from writers, writing groups, or service bodies within S.L.A.A.; and approves draft literature prior to submission for full Conference approval.
<b>2025-26 Conference Year Accomplishments</b>

<b>Challenges and constraints encountered in 2025-26</b>
Much time was spent during several CLC meetings attempting to resolve certain parts of the Literature Creation Editing and Publication (LCEP) process. The challenge arose as several projects were already in the pipeline when new members joined the CLC with different interpretations of the process. The CLC is planning to form a working group to refine those aspects of the LCEP workflow.

Many additional literature projects are in the process of development. Often the original writing group loses momentum and focus (life happens!) and the writing stops.
